



Notable Calls in the Village of Maple Bluff November 2023

The information provided below is about some of the call's officers responded to over the last month. Most narratives represent *early* and *preliminary* information that was gathered from those in the field who were actively working the cases. In many instances, facts and circumstances, even the type of crime listed, can change as the investigation unfolds.

11/01: Operating Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated Arrest – 12:33am. MBPD conducted a traffic stop on Fordem Ave/East Johnson Street for a vehicle observed speeding at 67mph in a posted 30mph zone. Upon contact with the driver of the vehicle, the officer investigated the suspicion of impairment. The investigation resulted in the 38-year-old male driver being arrested/cited for Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated (1st offense), Speeding, and Possession of THC.

11/05: Adult Arrested Person – 11:23pm. MBPD conducted a traffic stop on N. Sherman Avenue for an equipment violation. During the traffic stop investigation, the officer discovered the presence of Fentanyl. The 32-year-old male driver was arrested for Possession of Schedule II Narcotics and for a probation violation.

11/22: Resisting/Obstructing – 6:10pm. MBPD conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle on N. Sherman Avenue for an equipment violation. The vehicle came to a stop and the 23-year-old male driver opened the car door and fled the traffic stop on foot. Outside agencies responded with K9 and drone support to help locate the driver. The driver was later identified through investigation and charges referred to the DA's Office for Resisting/Obstructing.

11/25: Assist Other Agency – 8:05am. MPD requested MBPD provide mutual aid regarding a 48-year-old male wanted for eluding a Madison officer. A MBPD Officer observed the suspect vehicle, and a traffic stop was initiated. The wanted suspect was taken into custody and transported to Dane County Jail.

11/25: Assist Other Agency- 8:56am. MBPD observed a known wanted subject in the parking lot of 615 N. Sherman Avenue. The Officer had knowledge that the 31-year-old male was wanted by the MPD for Domestic Disorderly Conduct. The MBPD Officer took the subject into custody and turned him over to a MPD.
