



Notable Calls in the Village of Maple Bluff

April 2024

The information provided below is about some of the call's officers responded to over the last month. Most narratives represent *early* and *preliminary* information that was gathered from those in the field who were actively working the cases. In many instances, facts and circumstances, even the type of crime listed, can change as the investigation unfolds.

04/04: Adult Arrest – 11:32pm. MBPD attempted to conduct a traffic stop on a vehicle at N. Sherman/Roxbury Road. The driver refused to stop resulting in a vehicle pursuit. The driver eventually abandoned the vehicle and ran on foot where he was caught/arrested by MBPD. The 47-year-old male driver was taken to jail on charges of Eluding, 2nd degree Reckless Endangerment and Resisting.

04/06: Adult Arrest/Referred Charges – 8:50pm. MBPD attempted a traffic stop on a vehicle at N. Sherman Ave/Roxbury Road. The driver of the vehicle refused to stop, and a pursuit occurred. The pursuit was terminated, and an investigation has identified the 32-year-old driver and MBPD is pursuing charges of Eluding.

04/08: Disturbance/Protective Custody – 12:22am. MBPD observed a 54-year-old male causing a disturbance in the parking lot of 615 N. Sherman Avenue. An investigation determined that the male was extremely intoxicated and was taken into protective custody. No citations were issued, and the male was transported to Detox.

04/15: Adult Arrest – 7:41pm. MBPD conducted a traffic stop at N. Sherman/Oxford Place. The traffic investigation resulted in the recovery of drugs and over \$20,000 in cash. The 21-year-old male driver was arrested for two warrants through Dane County for Disorderly Conduct with a Domestic Enhancer and Operating a Firearm While Intoxicated. An active investigation is ongoing regarding the drug/cash recovery.

04/19: Adult Arrest – 7:58pm. MBPD conducted a traffic stop at North Sherman/Lakewood Blvd. on a vehicle. An occupant in the vehicle was on probation and had a warrant for their arrest. As result, the 55-year-old female was arrested and taken to jail for Resisting, Warrant and a Probation Hold.

04/19: Adult Arrest– 11:35pm. MBPD located an occupied stolen vehicle on N. Sherman Ave /Oxford Place. A traffic stop was attempted, and the vehicle refused to stop resulting in a pursuit. The stolen vehicle was eventually stopped by use of a tire deflation device and the driver was arrested. The 34-year-old female driver was taken to jail on the charges of

Operating a Motor Vehicle Without Owner's Consent, Eluding, 1st Degree Reckless Endangerment, and a Probation Hold.

04/21: Adult Arrest/Referred Charges – 5:54pm. MBPD conducted a traffic stop at North Sherman/Sherman Avenue. During the traffic investigation, it was learned that the driver had THC on his person and was currently out on bail. The 21-year-old male driver had charges referred for Possession of THC and Bail Jumping.

04/27: Adult Arrest/Referred Charges – 1:58am. MBPD conducted a traffic stop at N. Sherman/Sherman Ave. The traffic investigation resulted in the recovery of a loaded firearm. A 31-year-old male passenger had criminal charges referred for Carrying a Concealed Weapon.
