### § 192-4 Obstructions and encroachments.

**A.** Prohibited. No person shall encroach upon or obstruct or encumber any street, alley, sidewalk, public grounds or land dedicated to public use, or any part thereof, or permit such encroachment or encumbrance to be placed or remain on any public way adjoining the premises of which he is the owner or occupant, except as provided in Subsection **B**.

### § 192-14 Violations and penalties.

Unless otherwise provided for herein, any person violating any provision of this article shall be subject to a penalty under § 1-4 of this Municipal Code.

NOTE: An approved permit does not negate the responsible party listed above from using due care in the obstruction of the public right of way. The permit holder may need to provide additional safety cautions to assure the safe passage of the traveling public. An issued permit requires that the permit holder clean up all material at the end of each business day to that same condition as when they arrived. This may include a street sweeper or other devices to properly remove all materials. If there is a weather event, such as rain or sufficient wind while landscaping materials are located on the street surface, the permit holder or other responsible person at the site shall immediately removed all substances from the street surface to protect the integrity of the storm water system.
