



Notable Calls in the Village of Maple Bluff May 2024

The information provided below is about some of the call's officers responded to over the last month. Most narratives represent *early* and *preliminary* information that was gathered from those in the field who were actively working the cases. In many instances, facts and circumstances, even the type of crime listed, can change as the investigation unfolds.

05/02: Adult Arrest/Referred Charges – 11:32pm. MBPD contacted a bicyclist at N. Sherman/Oxford Place. The MBPD identified the bicyclist who was currently on probation and had an active warrant for his arrest from the Wisconsin Department of Corrections. The 39-year-old male bicyclist fled the police contact on his bicycle and the MBPD officer attempted to chase the suspect on foot but was unsuccessful. MBPD has referred charges on the suspect for Resisting/Obstructing.

05/05: Assist Other Agency/Adult Arrest – 1:44am. MBPD assisted the Madison Police Department via mutual aid regarding an attempted traffic stop on a vehicle that was traveling 85mph in a 35mph zone on East Washington Avenue. The suspect vehicle became disabled after a vehicle pursuit. The 35-year-old male suspect driver was eventually taken into custody after a short foot pursuit and taken to the Dane County Jail on charges of Felony Eluding, 2nd degree reckless endangerment and resisting/Obstructing law enforcement.

05/05: Adult Arrest/OWI – 8:31am. MBPD assisted the Madison Police Department at 2901 N. Sherman regarding a domestic disturbance. The 49-year-old female of the disturbance was seen leaving the area in a white sedan. MBPD observed this vehicle and made a traffic stop on it. After conducting an investigation, the female driver was arrested for Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated and was eventually released to a sober responsible party.

05/08: Adult Arrest/OWI – 11:22pm. MBPD conducted a traffic stop at N. Sherman/Sherman Avenue. The traffic investigation resulted in the arrest of the 39-year-old male driver for 3rd offense .02 BAC restriction and Bail Jumping. The driver was also cited for Operating a Motor Vehicle While Revoked.

05/12: Adult Arrest – 2:37am. MBPD conducted a traffic stop at North Sherman/Roxbury Road on a vehicle that was wanted by the Madison Police Department regarding the male/driver conducting in a sexual offense in the downtown area. The suspect vehicle eventually came to a stop after initially refusing to pull over. The 28-year-old male driver then fled the vehicle on foot and was caught/apprehended by the MBPD officer. The driver was booked into the Dane County Jail on MBPD charges of Eluding, Resisting arrest and a

probation violation. The Madison Police Department are still investigating the sexual offense case against the suspect.

05/14: Adult Arrest– 12:17am. MBPD was dispatched to a residence in the village regarding a disturbance. An investigation resulted in the arrest of a 31-year-old male for Disorderly Conduct and a Probation Violation.

05/18: Adult Arrest/Probation Violation– 12:28am. MBPD conducted a traffic stop at N. Sherman/Oxford Pl. The traffic investigation resulted in the arrest of the 30-year-old driver for a probation violation because he was in direct contact with the female passenger that was in the car with him at the time of the traffic stop.

05/18: Adult Arrest/Probation Violation – 11:12pm. MBPD responded to a residence in the village regarding a reported disturbance. The investigation resulted in the arrest of a 51-year-old male for a probation violation.

05/18: Hit & Run – 11:37pm. MBPD responded to a hit and run to a parked vehicle in the lot of 615 N. Sherman Avenue. An investigation resulted in the identification of the 32-year-old male suspect who confessed to the accident. The suspect was cited for Hit & Run to an unattended vehicle.

05/22: Adult Arrest – 6:15pm. MBPD conducted a traffic stop at N. Sherman/Oxford Place. A traffic investigation resulted in the arrest of the 41-year-old male for an active warrant through Dane County Sheriff's Office and for a probation warrant through the Wisconsin department of Corrections.

05/23: Adult Arrest – 12:21am. MBPD attempted a traffic stop at N. Sherman and Sherman Avenue on a vehicle with no license plates. The vehicle initially stopped and then fled the traffic stop as the officer approached the vehicle on foot. A vehicle pursuit was conducted but was eventually terminated by the MBPD officer. Mutual aid assistance from Madison PD resulted in the capture of the 37-year-old male driver and the 32-year-old male passenger after they were seen fleeing the suspect vehicle on foot on a dead-end street in the city of Madison. The driver was taken to the Dane County Jail on charges of Eluding, 1st Degree Reckless Endangerment. The driver also was in violation of his probation and was booked into jail on a probation hold.

05/24: Adult Arrest – 6:21pm. MBPD conducted a traffic stop at N. Sherman/Lakewood Blvd. The traffic investigation resulted in the recovery of a small amount of THC and a black bag containing 39 grams of suspected MDMA (Ecstasy). The 44-year-old female driver was placed under arrest and taken to the Dane County Jail on charges of Possession of Schedule 1 Narcotics.
