



Notable Calls in the Village of Maple Bluff June 2024

The information provided below is about some of the call's officers responded to over the last month. Most narratives represent *early* and *preliminary* information that was gathered from those in the field who were actively working the cases. In many instances, facts and circumstances, even the type of crime listed, can change as the investigation unfolds.

06/01: Adult Arrest/Recovered Stolen Auto/Recovered Stolen Firearm – 11:58pm. MBPD attempted to make a traffic stop on a vehicle at N. Sherman/Sherman Avenue for not displaying any registration plates. The vehicle refused to stop, and a pursuit was initiated. The vehicle became disabled after running over a tire deflation device. The driver and two other occupants ran from the vehicle and were eventually captured and placed under arrest. The 17-year-old driver, 17-year-old female passenger, and 17-year-old male passenger were taken to the Dane county jail on the referred charges of Operating a Motor Vehicle Without the Owners Consent, Possession of Stolen Property, Felon in Possession of a Firearm, Drug Possession, and multiple counts of Bail Jumping. Further investigation resulted in multiple other felony charges from outside agencies in Wisconsin and Illinois regarding a string of crimes committed by the three suspects.

06/03: Adult Arrest/OWI – 11:57pm. MBPD was dispatched to a vehicle stuck on the railroad tracks at Commercial Avenue/Superior Street. The MBPD investigation resulted in the arrest of a 35-year-old male for Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated (1st Offense). Additionally, the driver was cited for having a revoked driving status.

06/05: Adult Arrest – 3:10pm. MBPD attempted to stop a vehicle at N. Sherman/Oxford Place due to the registered owner having multiple warrants for her arrest. The vehicle did not stop, and a pursuit was initiated. The vehicle eventually became disabled, and the 23-year-old driver was arrested and taken to the Dane County Jail on referred charges of Eluding, 1st degree Reckless Endangerment, Resisting Arrest, Bail Jumping, Drug Possession, and Battery to a Law Enforcement Officer.

06/11: Adult Arrest – 4:51pm. MBPD conducted a traffic stop in the 400 block of N. Sherman. The traffic investigation resulted in referred charges of Felony Bail Jumping on the 42-year-old male driver. The driver was also cited for Obstruction, Operating with a Revoked Driving Status, and Child Safety Restraint Violation.

06/13: Adult Arrest – 6:01pm. MBPD conducted a traffic stop in the 600 block of N. Sherman Avenue on a vehicle that had no visible registration plates. The traffic investigation resulted

in the arrest of the 21-year-old male driver for Felony Bail Jumping. The driver was also cited for possession of THC.

06/14: Adult Arrest/Battery & Probation Violation – 8:18pm. MBPD was on patrol in the 600 block of North Sherman and observed a 43-year-old male sitting in the grassy area of the address with a female. The male was observed physically battering the female. MBPD arrested the male suspect and took him to jail on referred charges of Battery and a Probation Violation.

06/15: Hit & Run – 12:53pm. MBPD responded to a residence in the upper bluff for a reported hit and run to a mailbox. The MBPD investigation resulted in the location of the 22-year-old suspect who was cited for Hit & Run to Property.

06/19: Adult Arrest/Recovered Firearm– 8:38pm. MBPD conducted a traffic stop at N. Sherman/Oxford Pl. on a vehicle that was not displaying any registration plates. The traffic investigation resulted in the arrest of the 33-year-old driver for Possession of a Firearm by a Felon, Possession of a Short-Barreled Shotgun, Carrying a Concealed Weapon and Felony Bail Jumping. The driver was also cited for Operating with a Revoked Driving Status, Non-Registration of a Vehicle, and Failure to slow down/move over While Passing an Emergency Vehicle.

06/20: Adult Arrest – 3:00am. MBPD attempted to stop a motor vehicle exiting the Lakewood Plaza with no registration plates. The vehicle refused to pullover which resulted in a pursuit. The pursuit was terminated by MBPD and picked back up by the Madison Police Department in downtown Madison. The vehicle eventually became disabled, and the 52-year-old male driver was arrested and taken to the Dane County Jail on MBPD charges of Eluding, Reckless Endangerment, and Resisting Law Enforcement. Madison PD also referred charges for Eluding. It was later learned during the investigation that Fitchburg PD had probable Cause for the driver's arrest for a previous Eluding charge in their jurisdiction.

06/26: Adult Arrest – 7:58am. MBPD observed a vehicle at N. Sherman/Roxbury Road that had a known wanted subject associated with it. MBPD was able to make a traffic stop contact with the vehicle and arrest the 35-year-male passenger for two active warrants through Dane County Sheriff's Officer for prior felony drug charges. Further MBPD investigating resulted in the recovery of drugs within the vehicle. The passenger was taken to the Dane County Jail on the warrants and referred charges of Possession with Intent to Deliver Methamphetamine and two counts of Bail Jumping.

06/30: Adult Arrest – 1:57am. MBPD attempted to stop a motor vehicle at N. Sherman Ave/ Commercial Ave for a registration and vehicle window tint violation. The vehicle refused to pullover which resulted in a pursuit. The suspect vehicle became disabled, and the 19-year-

old female driver was taken into custody. The driver was booked into the Dane County Jail on charges of eluding, 2nd degree reckless endangering safety, and resisting an officer. The driver also received a municipal citation for failing to display license plates.
