



# Notable Calls

## Maple Bluff Police Department July 2024

*The information provided below summarizes some of the incidents that officers responded to over the past month. Please note that most narratives reflect initial and preliminary details gathered by personnel in the field at the time of the incident. As investigations progress, the facts, circumstances, and even the classification of the incidents may change.*

**07/05/24: Adult Arrest 12:34pm (Warrant)** – While on routine patrol, an MBPD officer conducted a traffic stop near the intersection of N Sherman Ave and Erie Ct. During the stop, the officer conducted a records inquiry and discovered that the front passenger of the vehicle had a felony arrest warrant issued by the Dane County Sheriff's Office for two counts of Possession of a Schedule I or II Narcotic, with full extradition. The 62-year-old female passenger was subsequently taken into custody without incident and transported to the Dane County Jail.

**07/06/24: 2 x Adult Arrests 9:40am (Probation/Parole Violation/Warrant)** – While conducting routine traffic monitoring in the 600 block of N Sherman Ave, an MBPD officer conducted a traffic stop for suspected license and equipment violations. During the stop, the officer identified the vehicle operator as being in violation of bond conditions related to two open felony circuit court cases. The driver, a 66-year-old male who was also on probation/parole, was taken into custody without incident. Wisconsin Probation and Parole was notified, resulting in a hold being placed on the suspect.

During the investigation, a passenger in the vehicle, who initially provided a false name, was found to be a fugitive wanted on felony and misdemeanor charges of Intent to Deliver Psilocin, Resisting/Obstructing an Officer, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. The 29-year-old male passenger was also taken into custody without incident.

**07/07/24: Adult Arrest 12:40am (Probation/Parole Violation)** – While conducting routine traffic monitoring in the 600 block of N Sherman Ave, an MBPD officer initiated a traffic stop near the intersection of N Sherman Ave and Lakewood Blvd. During the stop, the officer determined that the vehicle's operator was under active supervision by Wisconsin Probation and Parole due to multiple felony convictions, including Substantial Battery with Intent to Cause Bodily Harm and Resisting/Obstructing an Officer with Substantial Bodily Harm. The 25-year-old male driver was taken into custody without incident for violating his probation and was transported to the Dane County Jail.

**07/07/24: Adult Arrest 12:33pm (OWI 4<sup>th</sup> Offense)** – While conducting routine traffic monitoring in the 600 block of N Sherman Ave, an MBPD officer initiated a traffic stop for an observed equipment violation. During the stop, the officer made several additional observations that prompted an OWI/PAC investigation. The 37-year-old male driver was taken into custody and later found to have an alcohol concentration more than nine times the legal limit. Charges were referred for OWI 4th Offense and Operating After Revocation.

**07/07/24: 2 x Adult Arrest 7:39pm (Court Order Violations)** – While on routine patrol, an MBPD officer observed two individuals on foot in the 600 block of N Sherman Ave. The officer recognized the subjects—a 43-year-old male and a 52-year-old female—from previous professional encounters and was aware that both were under bond conditions prohibiting contact with one another due to their individual, open misdemeanor circuit court cases. The officer initiated contact, took both individuals into custody without incident, and transported them to the Dane County Jail.

**07/09/24: Adult Arrest 12:47pm (Court Order Violation)** – While on routine patrol, an MBPD officer conducted a traffic stop at the intersection of N Sherman Ave and Sherman Ave. During the stop, the officer observed signs that led to the seizure of suspected marijuana. A routine records inquiry revealed that the vehicle operator was in violation of bond conditions related to an open felony circuit court case. The 29-year-old male driver was taken into custody without incident and transported to the Dane County Jail.

**07/09/24: Adult Arrest 6:06pm (Court Order Violation)** – While on routine patrol, an MBPD officer conducted a traffic stop in front of 615 N Sherman Ave. During a routine records check, the officer discovered that the vehicle operator had one open felony and one open misdemeanor circuit court case. The officer also noted that the bond conditions for these cases prohibited the driver from having contact with the vehicle's passenger. The 29-year-old male driver was taken into custody without incident and transported to the Dane County Jail.

**07/10/24: Adult Arrest 3:14pm (Drugs)** – While on routine patrol, an MBPD officer initiated a traffic stop at the intersection of Commercial Ave and Superior St. Upon approaching the vehicle, the officer observed the front seat passenger in possession of drug paraphernalia. The passenger then locked his door and began smoking crack cocaine in the presence of the officer, disregarding lawful commands. The 42-year-old male passenger was eventually arrested and transported to the Dane County Jail. Charges referred include Felony Bail Jumping, Possession of Cocaine (2nd or Subsequent Offense), and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

**07/12/24: Adult Arrest 11:39pm (Threats/Resisting)** – While on routine patrol, an MBPD officer initiated a traffic stop at the intersection of Sherman Ave and Fordem Ave. During the investigation, the front seat passenger refused to comply with lawful commands and became disruptive. The officer observed that the 42-year-old male passenger appeared to be under the influence of intoxicants and was under active supervision by Wisconsin Probation and Parole. It was also noted that the passenger was in direct violation of his probation by consuming intoxicants. The individual resisted the officer's attempts to gain control but was eventually taken into custody. After his arrest, the subject issued verbal threats of physical harm directed at the officer. The male passenger was transported to the Dane County Jail without further incident, and charges were referred for Battery/Threats to Law Enforcement and Resisting/Obstructing.

**07/14/24: Adult Arrest 10:41pm (CCW-Firearm)** – While on routine patrol, an MBPD officer initiated a traffic stop at the intersection of N Sherman Ave and Erie Ct. During the stop, the officer made observations that led to a probable cause search of the vehicle. During the search, a loaded 9mm handgun was found concealed in the center console. The vehicle operator claimed ownership of the weapon but did not possess a permit to carry a concealed weapon, as confirmed by a routine records check. The 25-year-old male driver was taken into custody without incident and transported to the Dane County Jail on charges of Carrying a Concealed Weapon (Firearm).

**07/15/24: Adult Arrest 10:44am (Warrant/Probation Violation)** – While conducting routine traffic monitoring, an MBPD officer initiated a traffic stop in the 600 block of N Sherman Ave. During a routine records check, the officer discovered that the vehicle operator had a full extradition felony arrest warrant issued by the Wisconsin Department of Corrections. Additionally, the officer noted that the driver was under active supervision by Wisconsin Probation and Parole for Substantial Battery with Intent to Cause Bodily Harm. The 42-year-old male driver was taken into custody without incident and transported to the Dane County Jail.

**07/16/24: Vehicle Pursuit 12:40am** – While conducting routine traffic monitoring, an MBPD officer attempted to initiate a traffic stop at the intersection of N Sherman Ave and Commercial Ave. However, the vehicle disregarded the officer's visual and audible signals and accelerated to high speeds. Out of concern for public safety, the officer terminated the pursuit. The suspect vehicle was found abandoned in the roadway a short time later. This investigation remains ongoing.

**07/16/24: Adult Arrest 6:31am (Harassment Injunction Violation)** – An MBPD officer responded to a neighbor trouble complaint on Kensington Dr. Upon further investigation, it was determined that the 69-year-old female suspect involved in the complaint appeared to be in violation of a court-ordered harassment injunction. As a result, a charge for Violation of Harassment Injunction was forwarded to the Dane County District Attorney's Office.

**07/20/24: Adult Arrest 2:07am (OWI 5<sup>th</sup> Offense)** – While on routine patrol, an MBPD officer attempted to initiate a traffic stop at the intersection of N Sherman Ave and Lakewood Blvd. The vehicle initially disregarded the officer's visual and audible signals but continued operating at normal speeds before coming to a stop a short distance later. The officer discovered that the vehicle operator had a history of multiple OWI arrests and was subject to a .02 PAC restriction. Following the completion of an OWI investigation, the 36-year-old male driver was taken into custody without incident and later transported to the Dane County Jail on charges of OWI (5th offense) and Resisting/Obstructing.

**07/24/24: Adult Arrest 11:41am (Assist Other Agency/Weapons/Drug Offense)** – While on routine patrol near Warner Dr and Harbort Dr, an MBPD officer identified a vehicle connected to a recent weapons offense in the city of Sun Prairie. The officer was aware that a handgun had been displayed during the original incident and that the suspect remained at large.

The officer conducted a traffic stop and identified the suspect from the Sun Prairie incident inside the vehicle, leading to the suspect's arrest on Sun Prairie Police Department's active probable cause. It was also noted that the suspect was under active supervision by Wisconsin Probation and Parole for previous violations, including Possession of a Firearm by a Felon and 1st Degree Recklessly Endangering Safety. During a consent search of the vehicle, the officer discovered two loaded handguns near where the suspect had been seated. Additionally, a powdered substance was found and later field-tested, yielding a presumptive positive result for the presence of fentanyl.

The 39-year-old male driver was arrested and booked into the Dane County Jail without incident. A charge for narcotics possession against the 37-year-old female passenger was forwarded to the Dane County District Attorney's office for review.

**07/25/24: Adult Arrest 10:08pm (Warrant)** – While on routine patrol, an MBPD officer conducted a traffic stop in the 600 block of N Sherman Ave. The 35-year-old female driver was identified as a wanted individual and was taken into custody without incident. She was later transported to the Dane County Jail.

**07/25/24: Adult Arrest 11:24pm (Eluding)** – While on routine patrol, an MBPD officer attempted to initiate a traffic stop at the intersection of N Sherman Ave and Oxford Pl. The vehicle disregarded the officer's visual and audible signals and accelerated to higher speeds, engaging the officer in a vehicle pursuit. Within less than half a mile, the suspect vehicle became disabled, and the driver fled on foot. The officer pursued the suspect on foot, eventually apprehending the 33-year-old male driver. The suspect was arrested and transported to the Dane County Jail on charges of Fleeing/Eluding, Resisting, 1st Degree Recklessly Endangering Safety, and Reckless Driving.

**07/26/24: Adult Arrest 4:12pm (Drug Offense/Bail Violation)** – During routine traffic monitoring, an MBPD officer conducted a traffic stop at the intersection of N Sherman Ave and Michigan Ct. The 33-year-old male driver was taken into custody without incident for an active warrant and was later transported to the Dane County Jail.

Further observations led to a vehicle search for suspected narcotics. The search yielded a substance that later tested presumptively positive for cocaine, along with drug paraphernalia found in proximity to the driver's seat. Charges against the driver were subsequently forwarded to the Dane County District Attorney's office, including Possession of Cocaine (2nd or Subsequent Offense), Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, four counts of Felony Bail Jumping, and one count of Misdemeanor Bail Jumping.

**07/27/24: Adult Arrest 11:51pm (Shots Fired)** – While stationed near the intersection of N Sherman Ave and Sherman Ave, an MBPD officer heard what sounded like a gunshot. Shortly afterward, dispatch reported an incident involving a person with a gun on Superior St. Reporting indicated that a male suspect had fired a single shot toward a group of people during a disturbance before fleeing on foot. As the officer was investigating, dispatch reported that an unknown male

had entered a nearby backyard and assaulted another party. The officer noted that the suspect from this secondary incident matched the description of the alleged shooter from Superior St.

The MBPD officer responded to the area and located the suspect in the roadway near the intersection of Sherman Ave and Fuller Dr. The officer confronted the suspect, successfully gaining and maintaining control until backup officers from the Madison Police Department arrived. The contact was resolved safely, and the 27-year-old male suspect was taken into custody without incident. The suspect was then turned over to MAPD, and the investigation remains ongoing.

**07/29/24: Adult Arrest 12:51am (Assist Other Agency/Eluding)** – While on routine patrol, MBPD officers were requested for mutual aid to assist the Dane County Sheriff's Office with a disturbance investigation near the intersection of Milwaukee St and Stoughton Rd. While arriving on-scene, MBPD officers observed the suspect vehicle fleeing the area. The officers were aware that the male suspect had allegedly physically assaulted a female victim and fled from the investigating deputy. MBPD officers attempted to initiate a traffic stop, but the vehicle disregarded their visual and audible signals and accelerated to higher speeds, engaging the officers in a vehicle pursuit. The suspect vehicle was eventually stopped after the successful deployment of a tire deflation device by the DCSO. The 29-year-old male suspect was taken into custody and turned over to the DCSO for their ongoing investigation.
