



Notable Calls

Maple Bluff Police Department August 2024

The information provided below summarizes some of the incidents that officers responded to over the past month. Please note that most narratives reflect initial and preliminary details gathered by personnel in the field at the time of the incident. As investigations progress, the facts, circumstances, and even the classification of the incidents may change.

08/02/24: Adult Arrest 1:56am (Court Order Violation/Warrants) – While on routine patrol, an MBPD officer conducted a traffic stop near the intersection of N Sherman Ave and Lakewood Blvd. During the stop, the officer conducted a records inquiry and discovered that a passenger inside the vehicle had numerous felony and misdemeanor arrest warrants issued by the Dane County Sheriff's Office. The arrest warrants were for charges which included Bail Jumping, Battery, Substantial Battery-Intend Bodily Harm, Criminal Damage to Property, Operate a Firearm While Intoxicated, and Concealed Carry.

Additionally, the officer discovered that the vehicle passenger had two open felony circuit court cases. The officer noted that the bond conditions for these cases prohibited the passenger from consuming intoxicants. The passenger was determined to be in violation of their bond conditions. The 52-year-old male passenger was subsequently taken into custody for the warrants without incident and transported to the Dane County Jail on charges of two (2) counts of Felony Bail Jumping.

08/04/24: Adult Arrest 12:09am (Eluding) – While on routine patrol, an MBPD officer attempted to initiate a traffic stop near the intersection of Commercial Ave and Ruskin St. The vehicle disregarded the officer's visual and audible signals, then accelerated to higher speeds, engaging the officer in a vehicle pursuit. During the incident the MBPD officer recognized unfavorable conditions and terminated the pursuit.

The suspect vehicle was involved in a secondary pursuit with an outside agency shortly after the initial MBPD eluding incident. After the successful deployment of a tire deflation device the suspect vehicle became disabled. The vehicle operator fled from the vehicle on foot and was apprehended shortly thereafter. The 23-year-old male driver was taken into custody and transported to the Dane County jail on charges of Flee/Elude, Resist/Obstruct, and 2nd Degree Recklessly Endangering Safety.

08/14/24: Adult Arrest 12:49am (Eluding) – While on routine patrol, an MBPD officer initiated a traffic stop near the intersection of N Sherman Ave and Roth St. The vehicle initially stopped; however, upon the officer's approach, the vehicle accelerated away. The vehicle operator disregarded the officer's visual and audible signals, engaging the officer in a vehicle pursuit. After .5 miles the suspect vehicle became disabled, and the driver fled on foot. The MBPD officer pursued the operator, eventually apprehending the 26-year-old female driver. The suspect was arrested and transported to the Dane County Jail on charges of Fleeing/Elude, Resist/Obstruct, Possession of THC, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

Maple Bluff Police Department August 2024

08/17/24: Adult Arrest 12:28am (Warrant) – While on routine patrol, an MBPD officer conducted a traffic stop near the intersection of Aberg Ave and O’Neill Ave. The 58-year-old male driver was identified as a wanted individual and was taken into custody without incident. He was later transported to the Dane County Jail.

08/20/24: Adult Arrest 4:05pm (Eluding) – While on routine patrol, an MBPD officer initiated a traffic stop near the intersection of Sherman Ave and Harbort Dr. The vehicle initially stopped; however, upon the officer’s approach, the vehicle accelerated away. The vehicle operator disregarded the officer’s visual and audible signals, engaging the officer in a vehicle pursuit. Eventually the suspect vehicle became disabled, and the driver fled on foot. The MBPD officer pursued the operator, eventually apprehending the 37- year-old female driver. The suspect was arrested and transported to the Dane County Jail on charges of Fleeing/Elude, 1st Degree Recklessly Endangering Safety, Resist/Obstruct, Possession of Methamphetamine, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. Additionally, the suspect was placed on a probation hold for violation of her active supervision by the Wisconsin Department of Corrections.

08/21/24: Adult Arrest 10:14pm (Court Order Violation) – While on routine patrol, an MBPD officer conducted a traffic stop at the intersection of N Sherman Ave and Oxford Plc. During a routine records check, the officer discovered that the vehicle operator was the listed defendant in two (2) open felony circuit court cases. The officer also noted that the bond conditions for these cases prohibited the driver from operating a motor vehicle without a valid driver’s license. The 28-year-old male driver was taken into custody without incident and transported to the Dane County Jail on two (2) counts of Felony Bail Jumping.

08/25/24: Adult Arrest 12:01am (Eluding) – While on routine patrol, an MBPD officer attempted to initiate a traffic stop near the intersection of Lakewood Blvd and Fisk Plc. The vehicle disregarded the officer’s visual and audible signals, then accelerated to higher speeds, engaging the officer in a vehicle pursuit. During the incident the MBPD officer recognized unfavorable conditions and terminated the pursuit.

Upon conducting investigative follow-up, a 19-year-old-male suspect was identified and taken into custody without incident. The suspect was transported to the Dane County jail on a charge of Flee/Elude.

08/29/24: Adult Arrest 1:32pm (Drugs) – While on routine patrol, an MBPD officer initiated a traffic stop at the intersection of N Sherman Ave and Oxford Plc. Upon approaching the vehicle, the officer made observations which led to the initiation of a narcotics investigation. A 30-year-old female passenger was determined to be in possession of illicit items. Charges were referred to the Dane County District Attorney’s office for Possession of Cocaine, Possession of THC, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

08/30/24: Adult Arrest 7:19pm (Eluding) – While on routine patrol, an MBPD officer attempted to initiate a traffic stop near the intersection of Lakewood Blvd and Fisk Plc. The vehicle disregarded the officer's visual and audible signals, then accelerated to higher speeds, engaging the officer in a vehicle pursuit. The fleeing vehicle eventually came to a stop at the address of 365 Lakewood Blvd, where the 59-year-old-male driver was taken into custody after a brief struggle. The suspect was transported to the Dane County jail on charges of Flee/Elude, Resist/Obstruct, Felony Bail Jumping, and numerous outstanding felony warrants.
