



Notable Calls

Maple Bluff Police Department September 2024

The information provided below summarizes some of the incidents that officers responded to over the past month. Please note that most narratives reflect initial and preliminary details gathered by personnel in the field at the time of the incident. As investigations progress, the facts, circumstances, and even the classification of the incidents may change.

09/07/24: Adult Arrest 10:54pm (Eluding) – While on routine patrol, an MBPD officer observed a traffic violation near the intersection of N Sherman Ave and Commercial Ave. Upon observing the violation, the officer attempted to initiate a traffic stop near the intersection of Commercial Ave and Packers Ave. The vehicle disregarded the officer's visual and audible signals, then continued at normal roadway speeds. After traveling approximately 1 mile the suspect vehicle was brought to a stop by the use of a blocking maneuver. After a short struggle the 55-year-old male driver was taken into custody. The suspect was transported to the Dane County jail and was charged with Eluding, Resisting, Operating While Revoked, and Failure to Install an Interlock Device.

Additionally, the suspect, who was on parole and under active supervision through the Wisconsin Department of Corrections for OWI 5th was placed on a hold.

09/13/24: Adult Arrest 11:44pm (Warrants) – While on routine patrol, an MBPD officer observed a vehicle with multiple traffic violations near the intersection of N Sherman Ave and Roxbury Rd. Upon observing the violations, the officer conducted a traffic stop in the 1000 Blk of N Sherman Ave. The 41-year-old male driver was identified as a wanted individual and was taken into custody without incident. He was later transported to the Dane County Jail.

09/15/24: Adult Arrest 8:02am (Warrant) – While on routine patrol, an MBPD officer observed a vehicle with a registration violation near the intersection of N Sherman Ave and Roxbury Rd. Upon observing the violation, the officer initiated a traffic stop near the intersection of Roth St and O'Neill Ave. During the traffic stop a rear passenger was determined to have provided a false name. The passenger was later correctly identified as a wanted 26-year-old female. The female suspect was taken into custody without incident and transported to the Dane County jail.

09/23/24: Adult Arrest 1:19am (Warrant) – An MBPD officer, who was fueling a patrol squad observed a wanted subject in the parking lot of 2601 Shopko Dr. As a result, the officer initiated a traffic stop within the lot and contacted the vehicle operator. During the investigation the vehicle operator was confirmed to have an active Dane County arrest warrant. After a brief struggle the 24-year-old female suspect was taken into custody and transported to the Dane County jail.

08/25/24: Adult Arrest 4:47pm (Weapons Offense) – While on routine patrol, an MBPD officer observed a traffic violation near the intersection of N Sherman Ave and Lakewood Blvd. Upon observing the violation, the officer initiated a traffic stop in the 2000 Blk of Fordem Ave. During the traffic investigation the MBPD officer became aware of a concealed handgun in the possession of the vehicle operator. It was determined through a records inquiry that the vehicle

operator did not have a permit to possess a concealed firearm. The 29-year-old female suspect was taken into custody without incident. The suspect was transported to the Dane County Jail and was charged with Carrying a Concealed Weapon.

09/30/24: Adult Arrest 1:32pm (Warrant) – While on routine patrol, an MBPD officer observed a registration violation near the intersection of N Sherman Ave and Lakewood Blvd. Upon observing the violation, the officer initiated a traffic stop at the intersection of Superior St and Michigan Ct. The operator of the vehicle was uncooperative and attempted to walk away from the traffic stop. It was determined that the vehicle operator had an active warrant for their arrest. The 29-year-old male suspect was taken into custody without incident. Upon the completion of the investigation the suspect was transported to the Dane County jail for his warrant and a charge of a Carrying a Concealed Weapon.

Additionally, the suspect, who was on probation and under active supervision through the Wisconsin Department of Corrections for Felony Bail Jumping and Possession of Narcotic Drugs was placed on a hold.
