



Notable Calls

Maple Bluff Police Department October 2024

The information provided below summarizes some of the incidents that officers responded to over the past month. Please note that most narratives reflect initial and preliminary details gathered by personnel in the field at the time of the incident. As investigations progress, the facts, circumstances, and even the classification of the incidents may change.

10/03/24: Adult Arrest 8:20pm (Warrant) – While on routine patrol, an MBPD officer observed a vehicle with a registration violation near the intersection of N Sherman Ave and Lakewood Blvd. Upon observing the violation, the officer initiated a traffic stop near the intersection of Sherman Ave and Fuller Dr. During the traffic stop the vehicle operator was determined to have an active arrest warrant through the Jefferson County Sheriff’s Office. The 22-year-old, male suspect was taken into custody without incident and transported to the Dane County jail.

10/04/24: Adult Arrest 9:55pm (Domestic Disturbance) – The MBPD was dispatched to an address in the Village of Maple Bluff for a check person call. MBPD officers responded to the residence and determined that a disturbance had taken place. Upon the completion of the MBPD investigation a 55-year-old male was taken into custody and later booked into the Dane County jail on charges including Domestic Battery, Domestic Disorderly Conduct, Obstructing or Resisting an Officer, Threats to Law Enforcement, and Discharging Bodily Fluids at a Public Safety Worker.

10/05/24: Adult Arrest 8:58pm (Warrant) – While on routine patrol, an MBPD officer observed a vehicle with an equipment violation near the intersection of N Sherman Ave and Sherman Ave. Upon observing the violation, the officer initiated a traffic stop near the intersection of Commercial Ave and Superior St. During the traffic contact the vehicle operator was determined to have an active arrest warrant through the Dane County Sheriff’s Office. The 30-year-old, male suspect was taken into custody without incident and transported to the Dane County jail.

10/11/24: Adult Arrest 8:30pm (Drug Investigation)- While on routine patrol, an MBPD officer observed a vehicle with a registration violation near the 600 block of N Sherman Ave. Upon observing the violation, the officer initiated a traffic stop near the intersection of N Sherman Ave and Aberg Ave. During the stop the MBPD officer made observations which transitioned the vehicle contact into a narcotics investigation. As a result, the 21-year-old vehicle operator was taken into custody, booked into the Dane County jail, and charged with Possession of Cocaine.

10/15/24: Adult Arrest 3:52pm (Probation Violation)- While on routine patrol, an MBPD officer observed a vehicle operator engaged in a driver’s license violation near the 600 block of N Sherman Ave. Upon observing the violation, the officer initiated a traffic stop near the intersection of Pennsylvania Ave and Packers Ave. During the traffic contact the vehicle operator was determined to be under active supervision by the Wisconsin Department of Corrections for Burglary while Armed and OWI 4th Offense. The MBPD officer noted that the vehicle operator was in

violation of the rules of their probation. The 25-year-old, male vehicle operator was taken into custody without incident and transported to the Dane County jail on a Probation Hold.

10/16/24: Adult Arrest 1:11am (OWI and Warrants)- While on routine patrol, an MBPD officer observed a vehicle with a registration violation near the 600 block of N Sherman Ave. Upon observing the violation, the officer initiated a traffic stop near the intersection of Commercial Ave and Superior St. During the traffic stop the vehicle operator was determined to have an active arrest warrant through the Racine County Sheriff's Office. Additionally, the MBPD officer made observations which led to an Operating While Under the Influence investigation. As a result, the 41-year-old, male suspect was taken into custody without incident, transported to the Dane County jail, and was charged with OWI 1st.

10/21/24: Adult Arrest 11:06pm (Weapons Offense) – While on routine patrol, an MBPD officer observed a moving violation near the intersection of N Sherman Ave and Sherman Ave. Upon observing the violation, the officer initiated a traffic stop in the parking lot of 615 N Sherman Ave. During the traffic stop the MBPD officer made observations which transitioned the vehicle contact into a narcotics investigation. During the investigation a loaded handgun with an extended magazine was located in a concealed location on the operator's person. It was determined that the suspect did not have a permit to carry a concealed firearm. The 51-year-old male suspect was transported to the Dane County jail and was charged with Carrying a Concealed Weapon (CCW).

10/22/24: Adult Arrest 11:00pm (Warrant) – While on routine patrol, an MBPD officer observed a vehicle associated with a wanted subject near the intersection of N Sherman Ave and Lakewood Blvd. Upon observing the vehicle, the officer conducted a traffic stop in the parking lot of 615 N Sherman Ave. The 27-year-old male vehicle operator was identified as the wanted individual and taken into custody without incident. He was later transported to the Dane County Jail.

10/25/24: Adult Arrest 11:51pm (Warrant) – While on routine patrol, an MBPD officer observed a vehicle associated with a wanted subject near the intersection of N Sherman Ave and Sherman Ave. Upon observing the vehicle, the officer conducted a traffic stop near the intersection of N Sherman Ave and Boyd Ave. The 49-year-old male vehicle operator was identified as the wanted individual and taken into custody without incident. He was later transported to the Dane County Jail.
